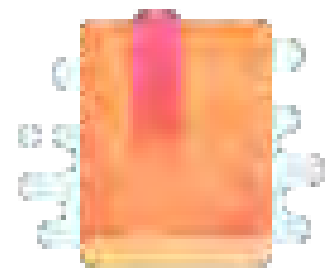




National Library of Thailand
